

How To Make the No-Rehearsal Christmas Pageant Costumes

This PDF contains:

- sheep mask to print and cut out
 - instructions to make a shepherd's head scarf
 - cardboard crown to print and cut out
 - cardboard animal head bands to print and cut out

1. How to make the sheep mask:

1. Print the mask on paper or cardstock.
 2. Optional: Cut carefully along the outside line.
 3. Optional: Add a handle so you can hold the mask in front of your face.

2. How to make a shepherd's head scarf:

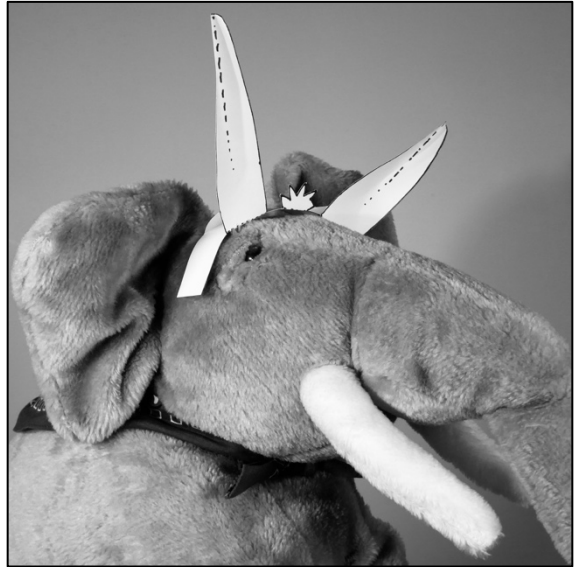
Take a pillow case, or any piece of cloth about that size. Drape it over your head. Here's Elephant with a head scarf:



3. How to make the animal ears:

1. Print the ears on paper or cardstock.
2. Cut along the heavy solid lines.
3. Fold the ears so they stand up.

Here's Elephant with the donkey ears:



4. How to make the Wise Person's crowns and Herod's crown:

1. Color in both halves of the crown.
2. Cut out both halves of the crown.
3. Tape both halves together together to make one big crown.

It will work best if you put tape BOTH ON THE INSIDE, AND ON THE OUTSIDE.

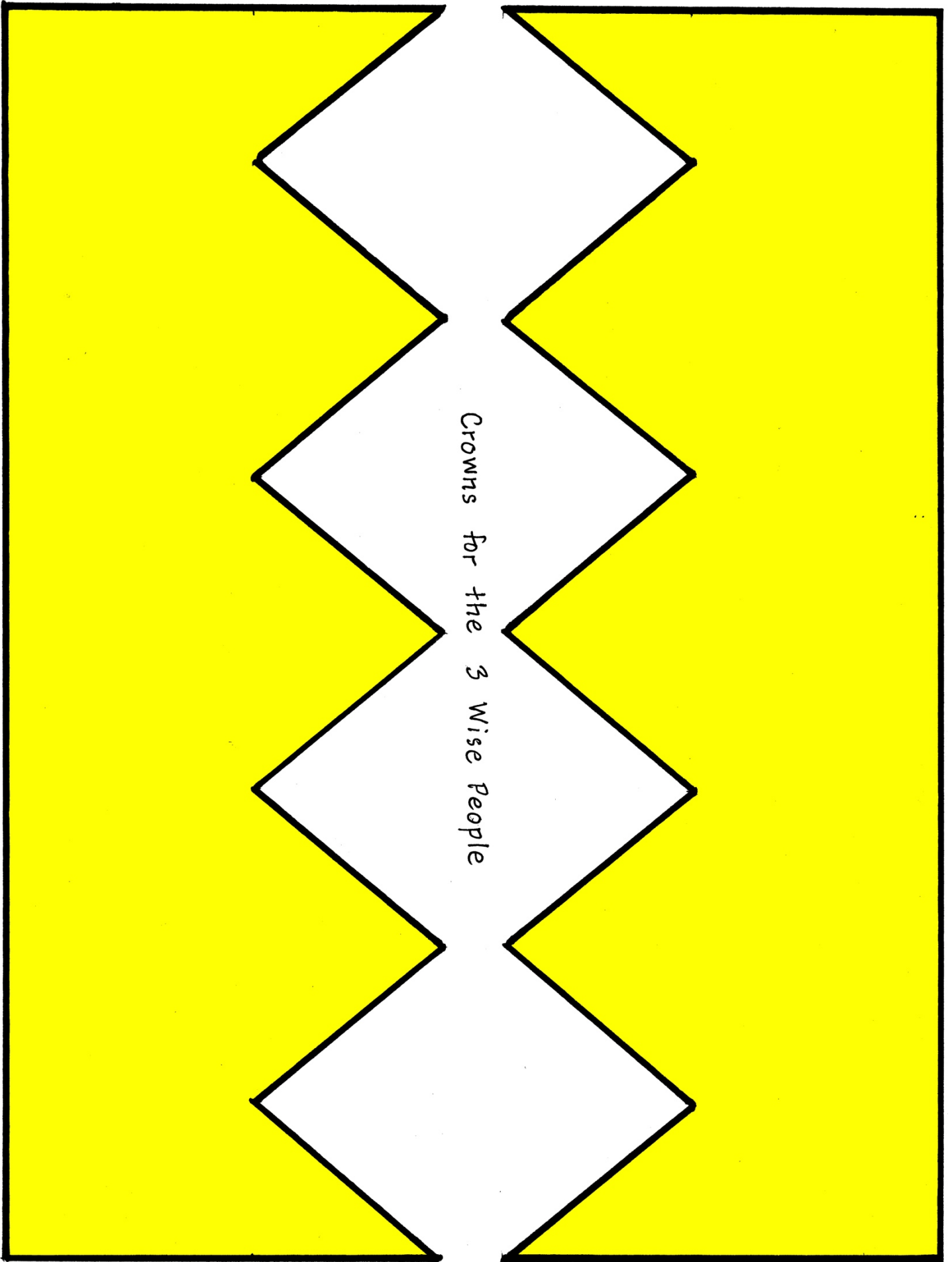
How To Use These:

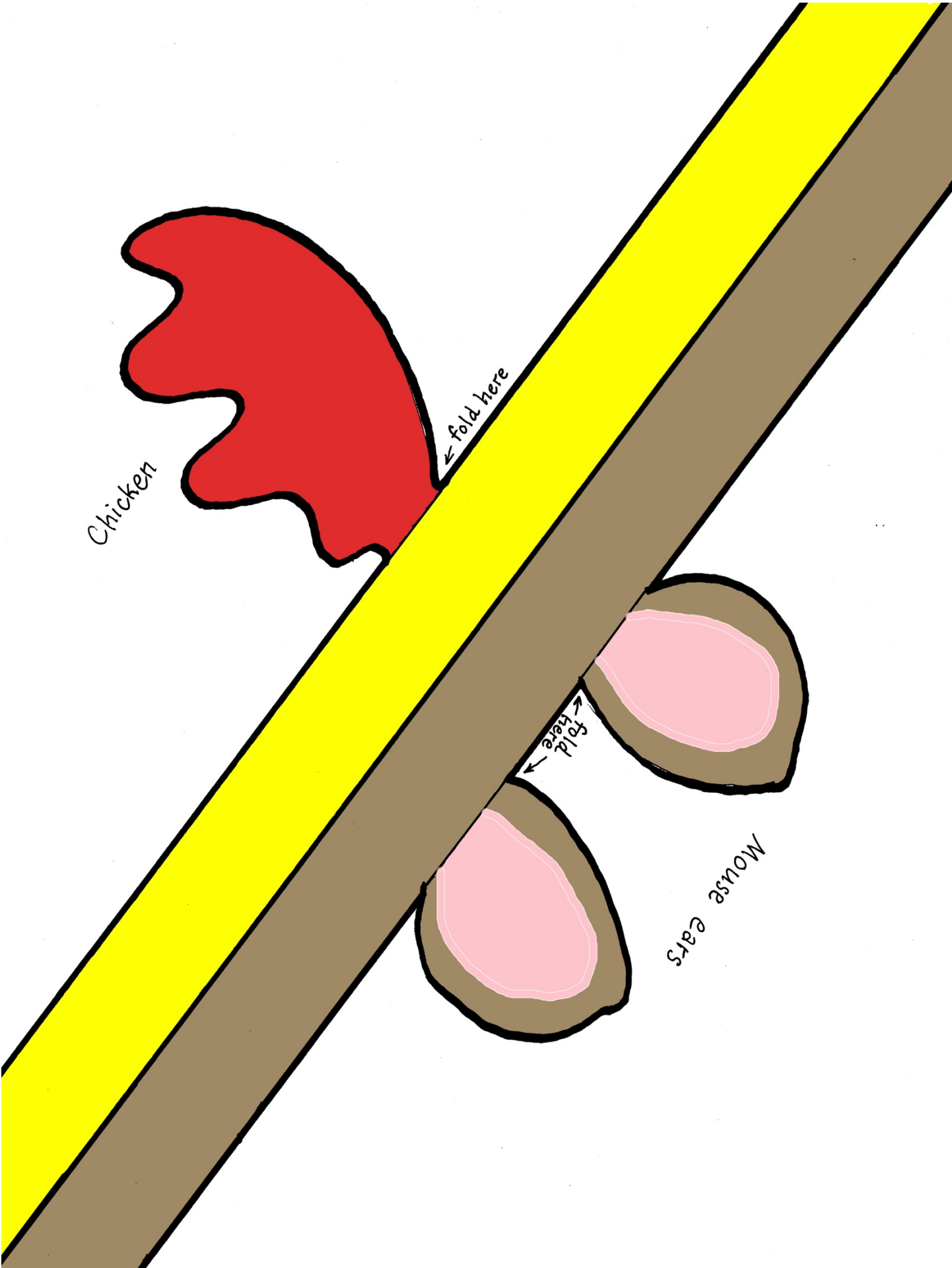
Print and cut out ONE each of Laurel Leaves and Herod's Crowns.

Get as many Head Scarves as you have time for.

Crowns for the 3 Wise People



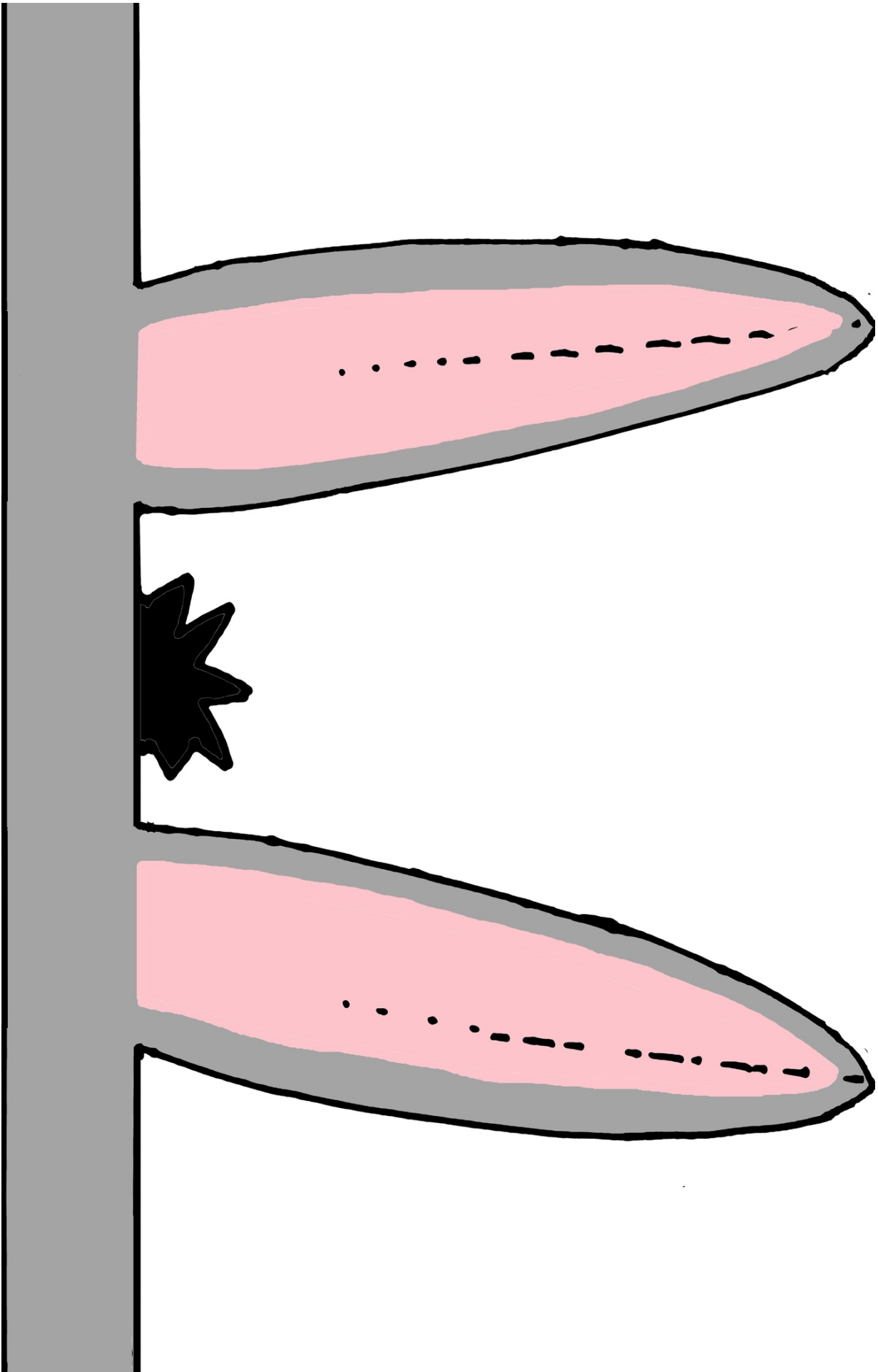


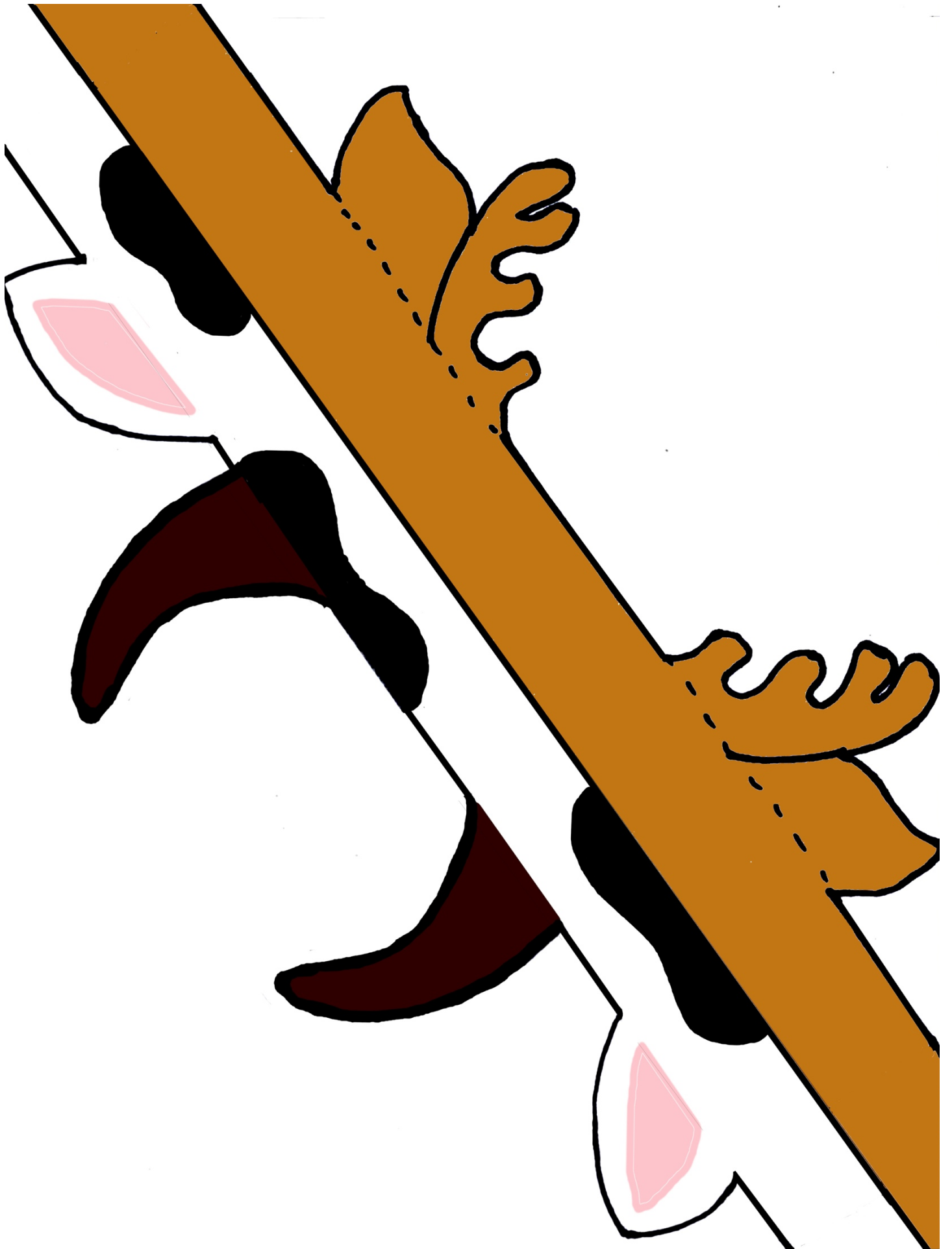
